### **FEATURE STORY:**

#### China 2 Week Special 2014

During the months of July and August our Projects Abroad community has welcomed 2 Week Special volunteers in each of our 30 destinations across the globe. The 2 Week Specials (also known as High School Specials for Americans) are high school students aged between 16 and 19-years-old who work in these destinations for two weeks. During their two weeks, they live in either host families or shared accommodation while our staff give them 24 hour support, arrange their transport, placement visits and join them for evening and weekend adventures. One of the main purposes of these programmes is to give these young people a real cultural experience, while at the same time allowing them to see life in a different country as one of the locals while actually working. It is evident that by becoming immersed in the culture in this way, it can lead to these volunteers developing a perspective that one cannot gain from visiting a country as a tourist. Additionally, we have a young team of staff at Projects Abroad, most having graduated in the last few years. Therefore, we can give the volunteer's advice about university, and other aspects of life, that we wish we knew when we were teenagers.
